

Co-operative Engagement | The Frame

A 'Frame' helps to begin the engagement process and provides a way to capture and share information before embarking on work to inform, involve or collaborate with people and communities.

The Frame

Who is setting the Frame?	
Frame Topic	
Step 1	When and why?
Who is the main audience for this topic?	<i>For example, do you want to reach a specific geographic community, community of identity or experience, or users and staff and specific service?</i>
What do you want to ask and why?	<i>What is the information you need? Do you have a central question in mind?</i>
What do you aim to influence?	<i>What decisions have already been made or restricts planning e.g. strategies in place, policies and procedures, timeframes and available resources?</i>
What do we already know?	<i>What is the data and insight you already have? Where can you find that?</i>
What else do we need to know?	<i>Let's review. Looking at the data and insight you already have. Is that enough information to proceed? Are there any gaps? Do you want to refresh your main question or audience?</i>
Step 2	How?
What level of engagement is needed?	<i>Information giving (universal/targeted) Involve (understanding experiences and opinions around the frame topic) Collaborate (working together to understand the topic and develop solutions)</i>
Who will be delivering the engagement?	<i>Who will be leading the conversations on the ground? Is it a mix of people across the sector/system?</i>
What is your methodology of engagement?	<i>What type of engagement, or tools, do you want to use? Will it be surveys or workshops, games or long tables, or a mixture, there are so many to choose from? Are the spaces safe and inclusive?</i>
What resources do you have?	
What support do you need?	

Step 3	Impact?
<p>Has it been beneficial for everyone involved?</p>	<p><i>Have you gone back to the people involved to agree what it means and what difference it'll make?</i></p>
<p>What action now needs to take place?</p>	<p><i>Is there a model / decision / recommendation? Are you producing an enlightening summary or completing the insight capture template?</i></p>
<p>Once the action has taken place what can you capture and where can you share what you've learnt?</p>	<p><i>Record what has happened as a result of the engagement? Think about the influence and audience – can you share this somewhere so that everyone can find it? Are there decision-making bodies so the people who need to, can hear about it and influence the way things are done?</i></p>
